**CAUT** IS PLEASED TO PUBLISH its first Almanac of Post-Secondary Education in Canada. The annual *CAUT Almanac* brings together a wealth of information about Canada's universities and colleges in an accessible format for students, academic staff, journalists and the public.

The object of the *Almanac* is to give a factual overview of what is known about post-secondary education in Canada. We hope its design and presentation will prove useful. For those wanting to explore a topic in greater depth, we provide a list of sources and notes at the end.

As we gathered the data for this document, we became aware both of the rich detail on some important matters and the almost total absence of data on others. For example, extensive data are gathered about how many students there are and what courses they take, but very little is collected to give an overall sense of who these students are. We know almost nothing about their socio-economic status and even less about their cultural, racial and ethnic backgrounds.

Similarly, considerable data are collected about full-time academic staff, although there is a conspicuous omission of data that would provide a complete demographic profile of full-time faculty and other academic staff. An even more troubling gap is the almost total absence of reliable information about the huge number of part-time and contract academic staff.

In future editions of the *CAUT Almanac*, we will fill those gaps as data are collected by Statistics Canada or other researchers. We would be pleased to receive suggestions for future editions which will be published in January of each year. Additional copies of the *CAUT Almanac* may be ordered by email (acppu@caut.ca).

**L'ACPPU** A LE PLAISIR D'ANNONCER la publication de son premier almanach de l'enseignement post-secondaire au Canada. Publication annuelle, l'*Almanach de l'ACPPU* renferme une mine de renseignements sur les universités et les collèges du Canada dans un format accessible pour la population étudiante, le personnel universitaire, les journalistes et le grand public.

L'*Almanach* présente un aperçu factuel qui a pour objet d'informer sur l'enseignement postsecondaire au Canada. Nous espérons que sa conception et sa présentation se révéleront utiles. Les personnes désirant approfondir un sujet pourront consulter les sources et les notes fournies à la fin.

Alors que nous rassemblions les données pour cet ouvrage, nous nous sommes rendus compte de l'abondance de renseignements sur certains sujets et la quasi-absence de données sur d'autres. Ainsi, énormément de données sont recueillies sur le nombre d'étudiants et sur les cours qu'ils suivent, mais très peu sont rassemblées nous permettant d'avoir une idée générale de leur profil. Nous ne savons presque rien sur leur situation socio-économique, voire sur leur origines culturelles, raciales et ethniques.

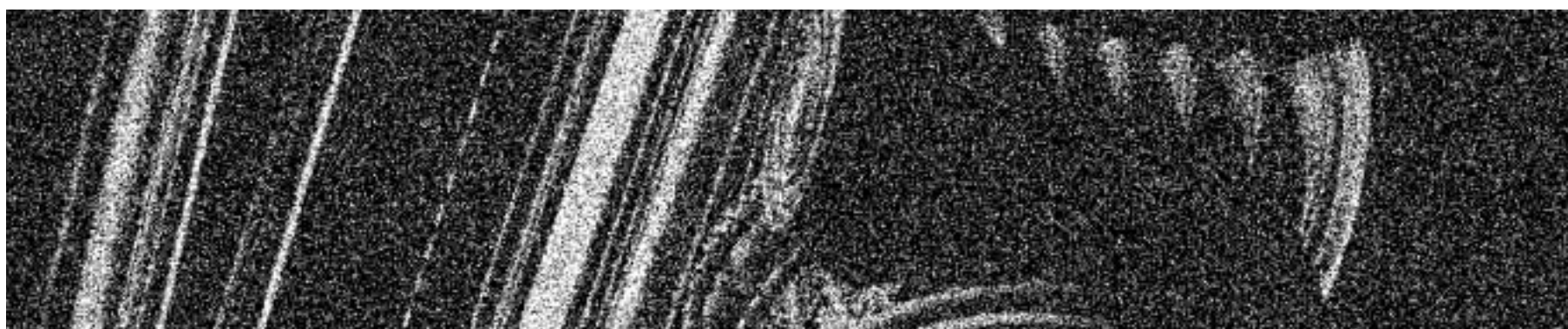
De même, une grande quantité de données est colligée sur le personnel universitaire à temps plein mais il manque manifestement des renseignements pour broser un tableau démographique complet des professeurs et autres universitaires à temps plein. L'absence presque totale de renseignements fiables sur le nombre considérable d'universitaires à temps partiel et de contractuels est encore plus inquiétante.

Nous comblerons ces omissions dans les éditions futures de l'*Almanach de l'ACPPU* à mesure que des données seront colligées par Statistique Canada et d'autres chercheurs. Nous accueillerons avec plaisir les suggestions pour les éditions futures qui paraîtront annuellement, en janvier. 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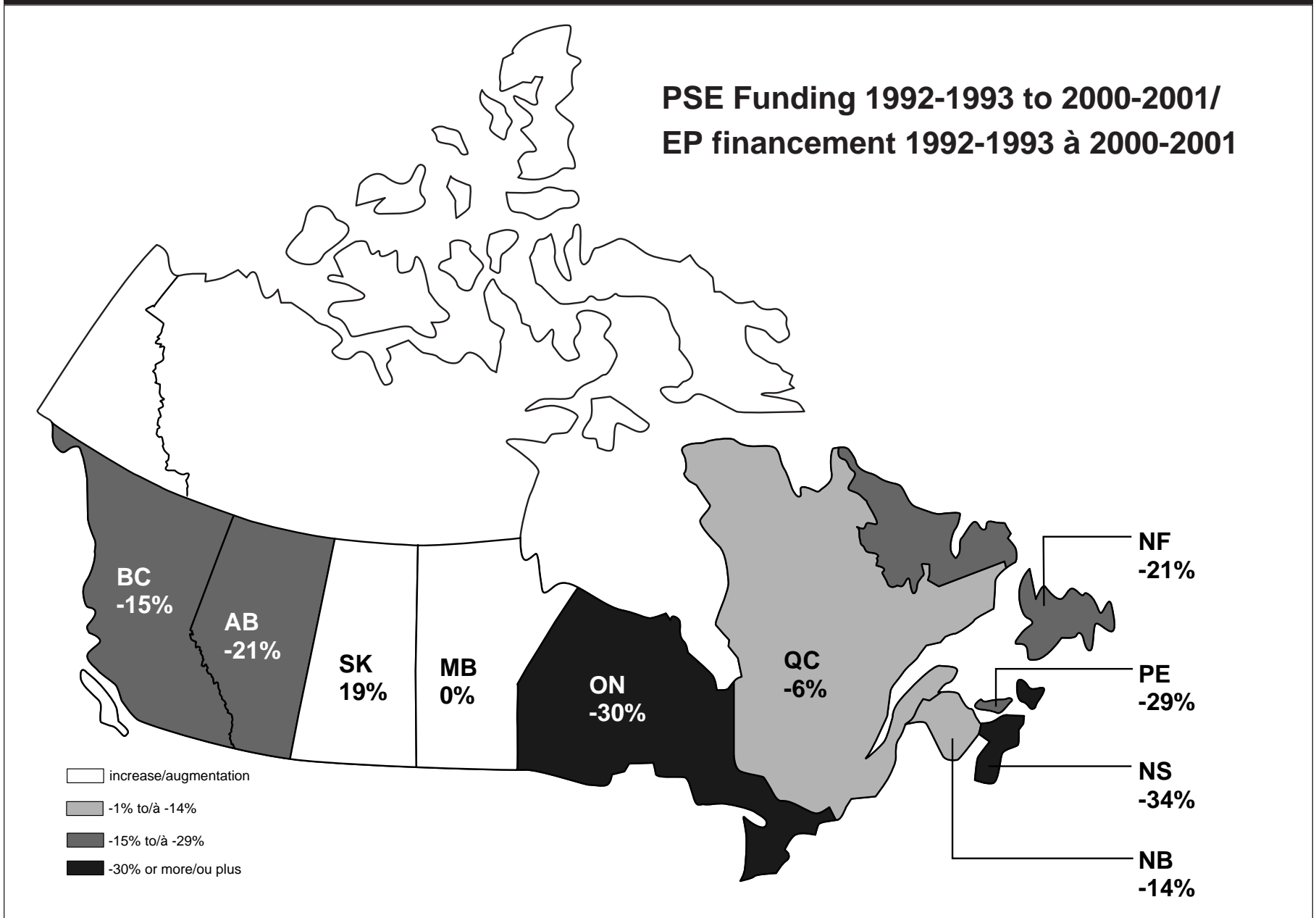

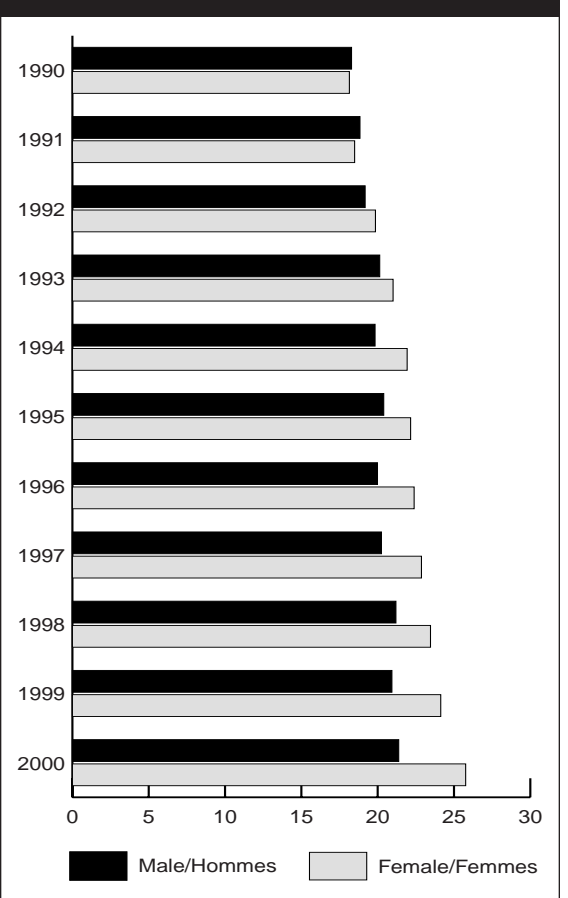

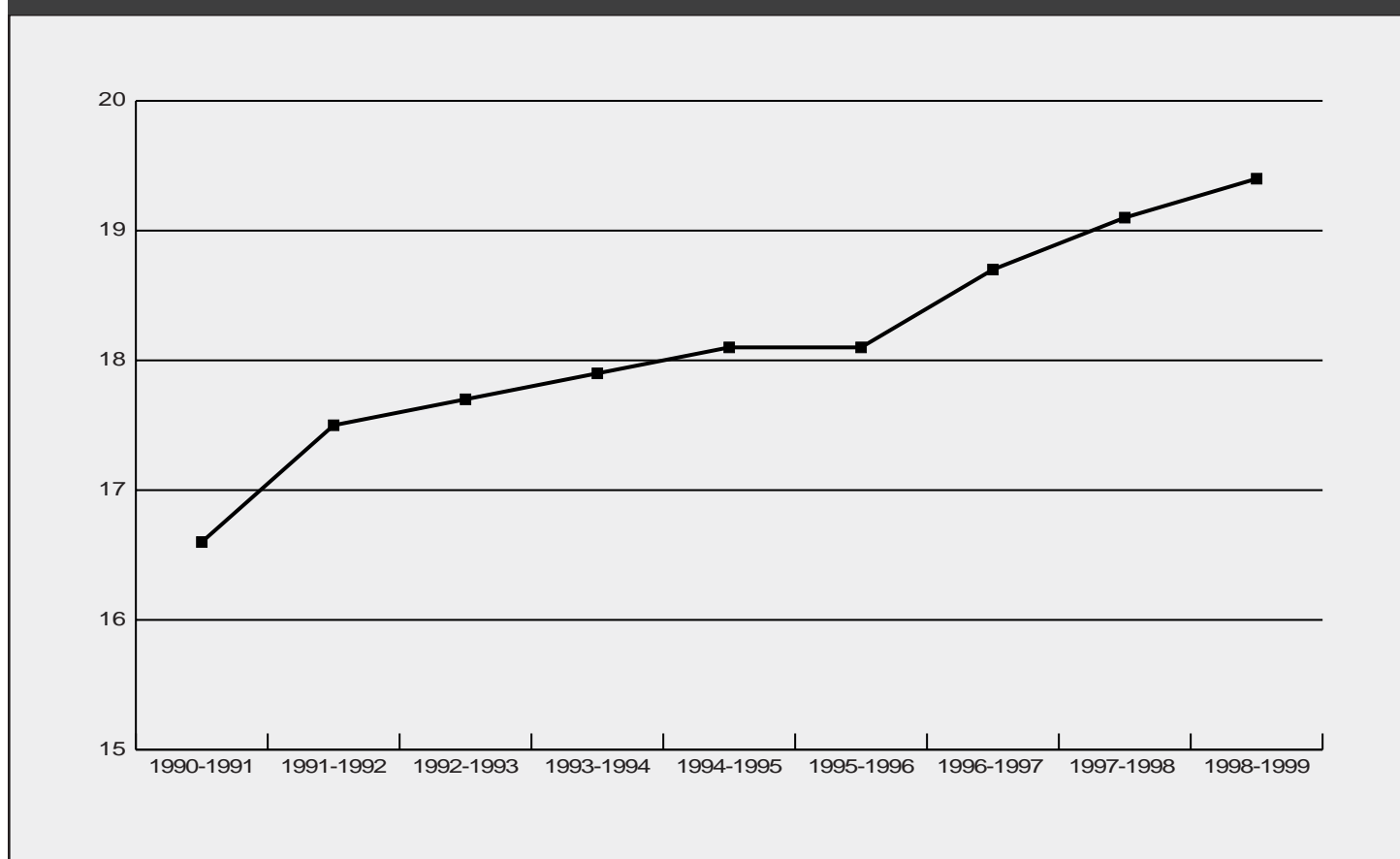

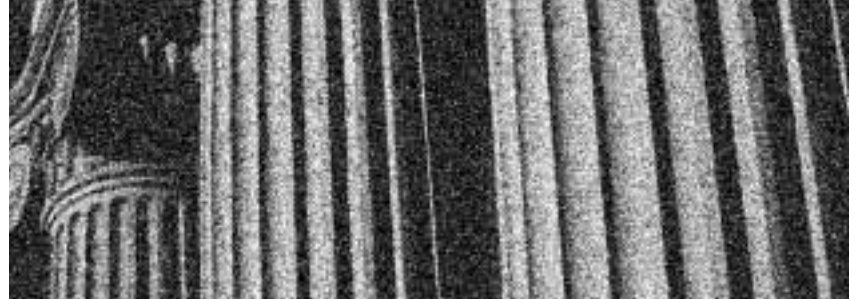

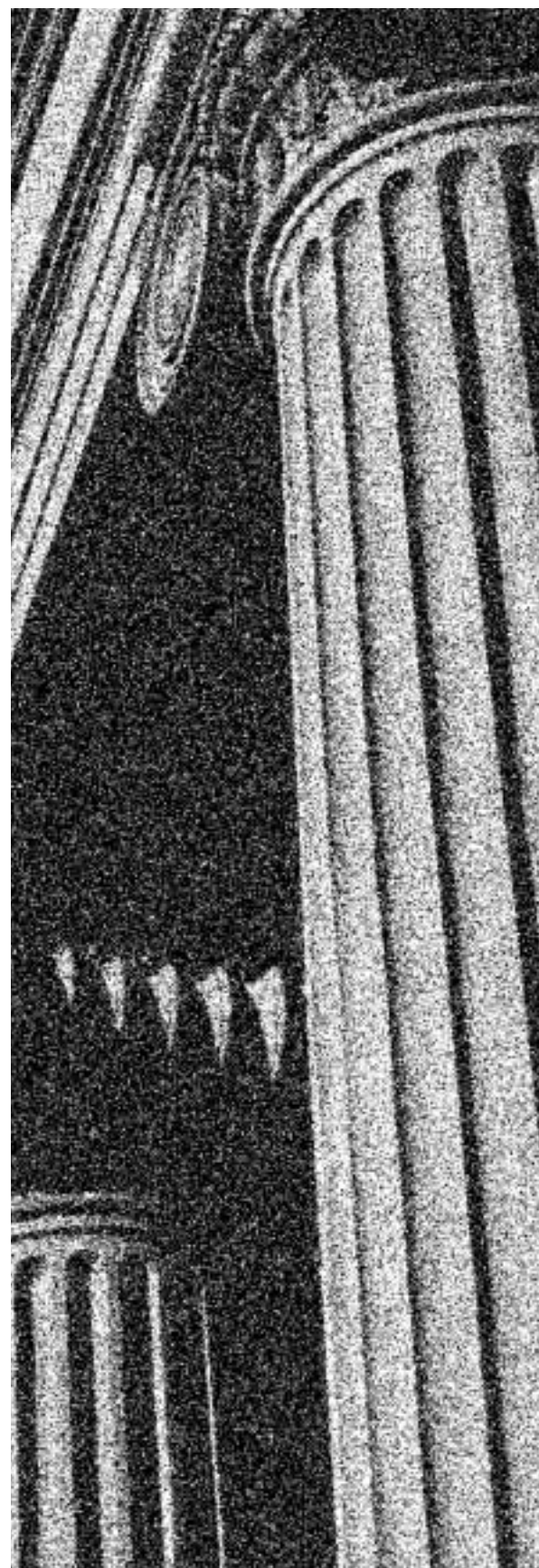

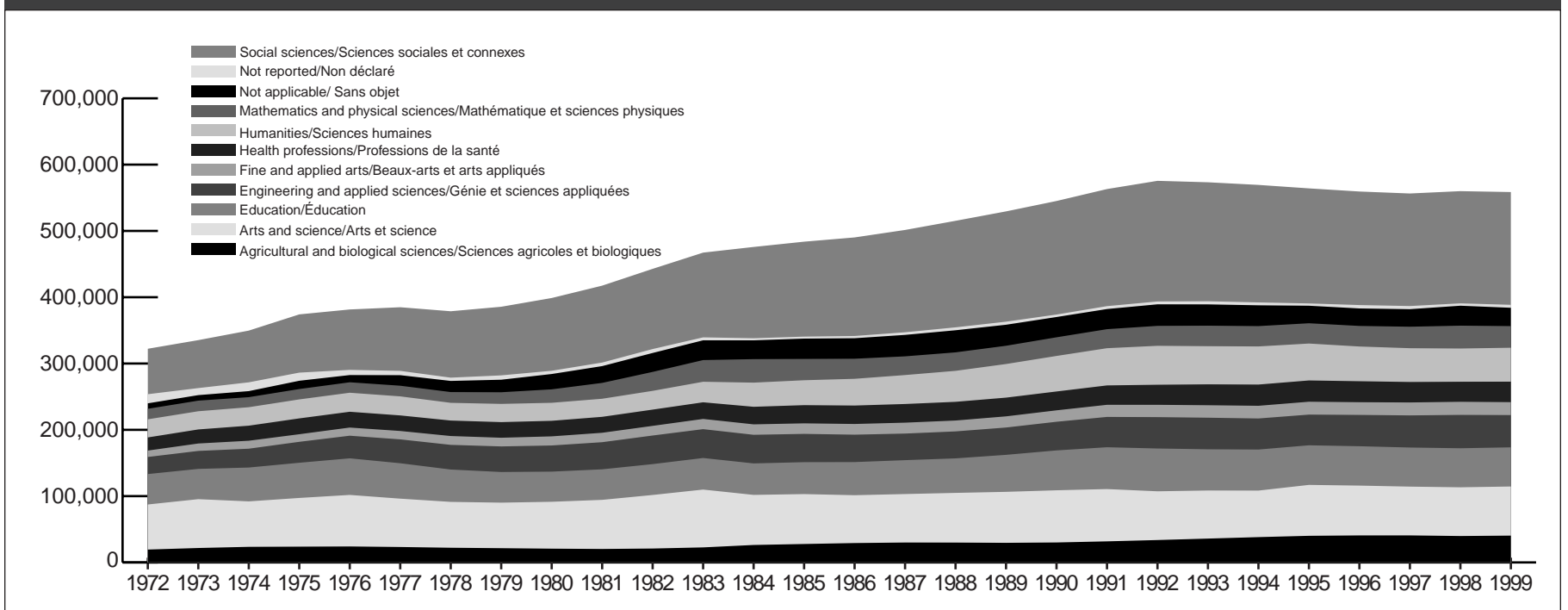

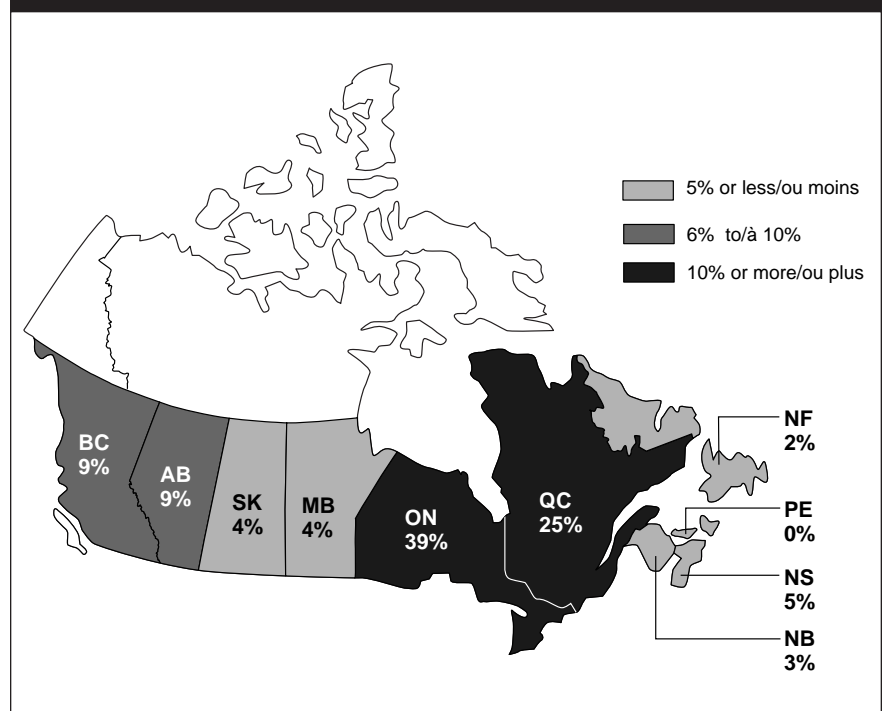

1998-1999**



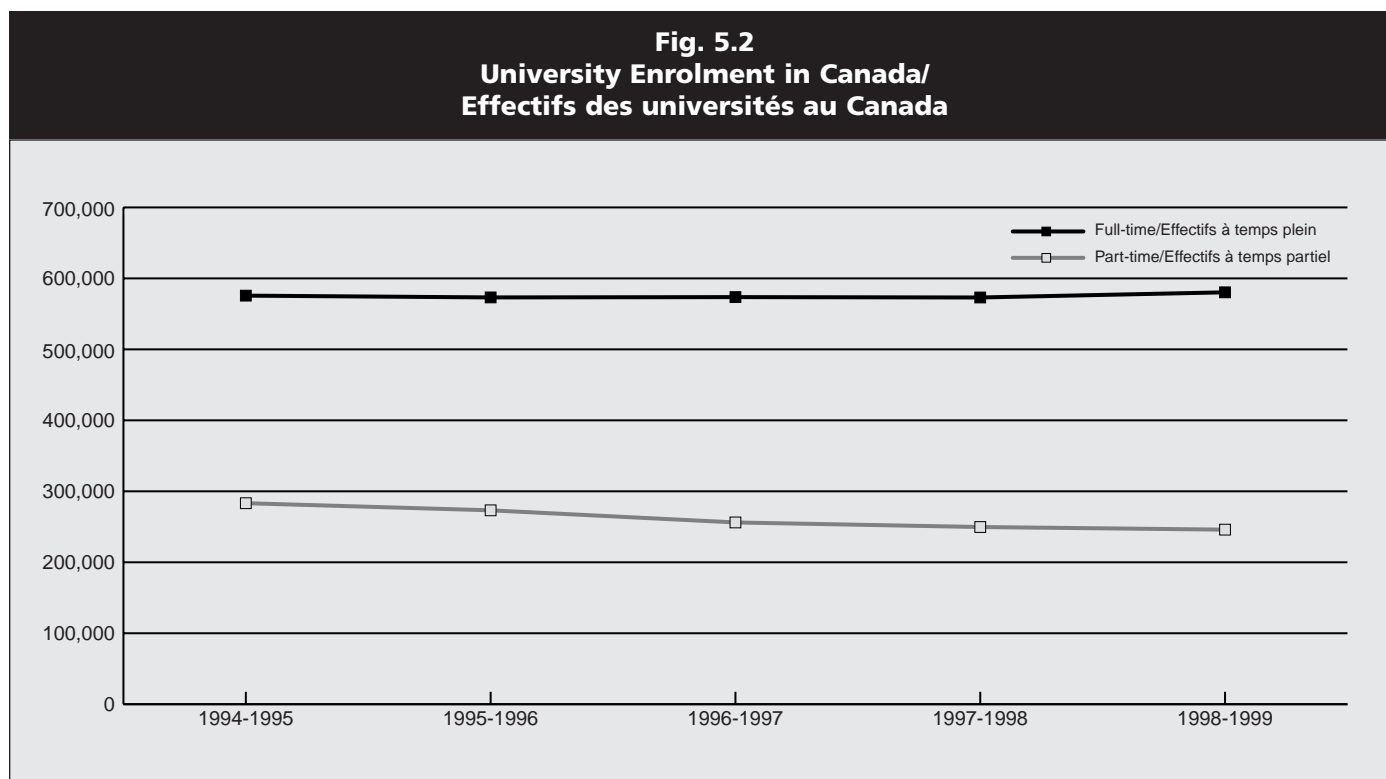

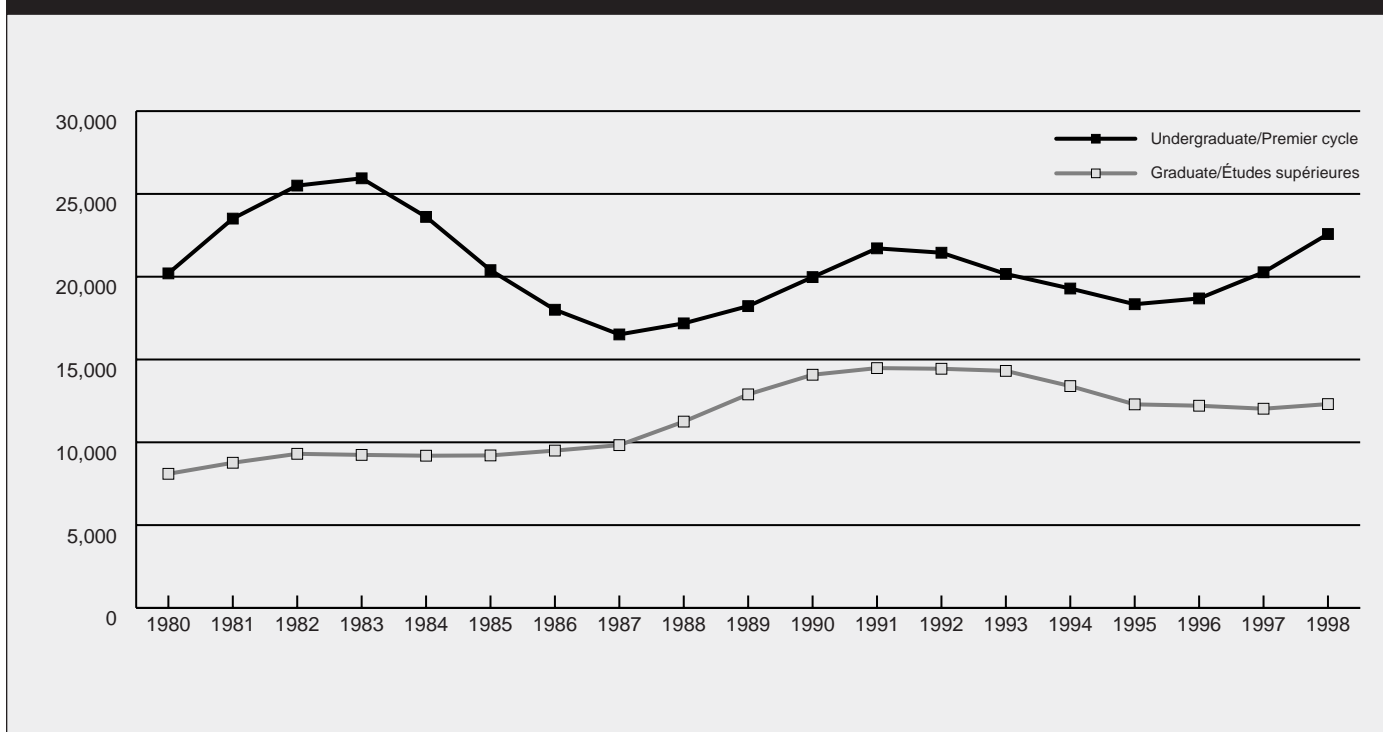

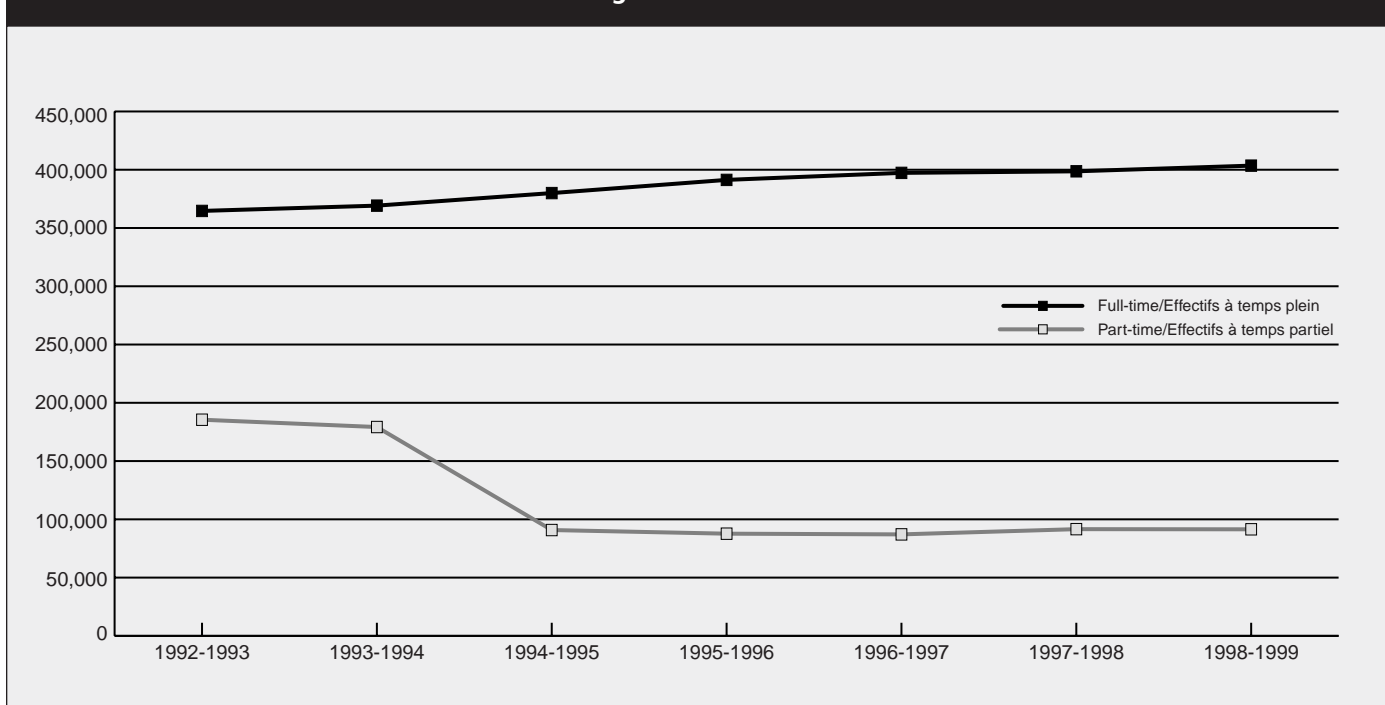

**décernés (1998)**

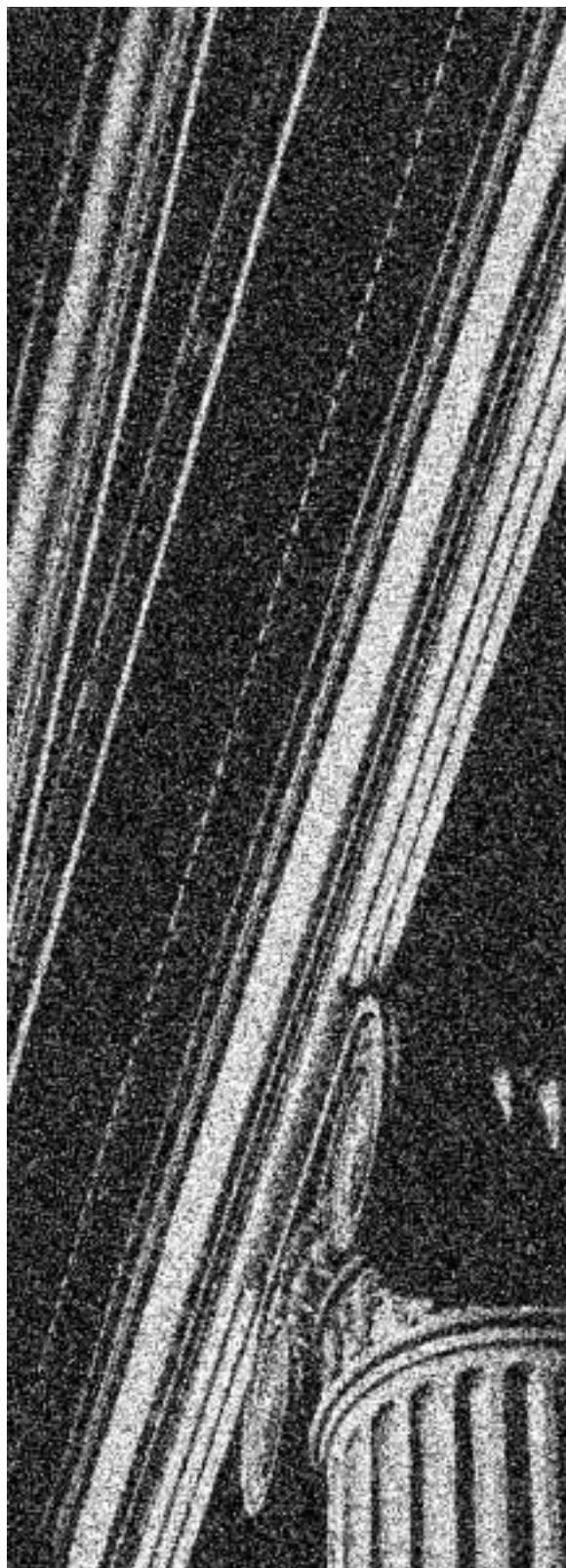

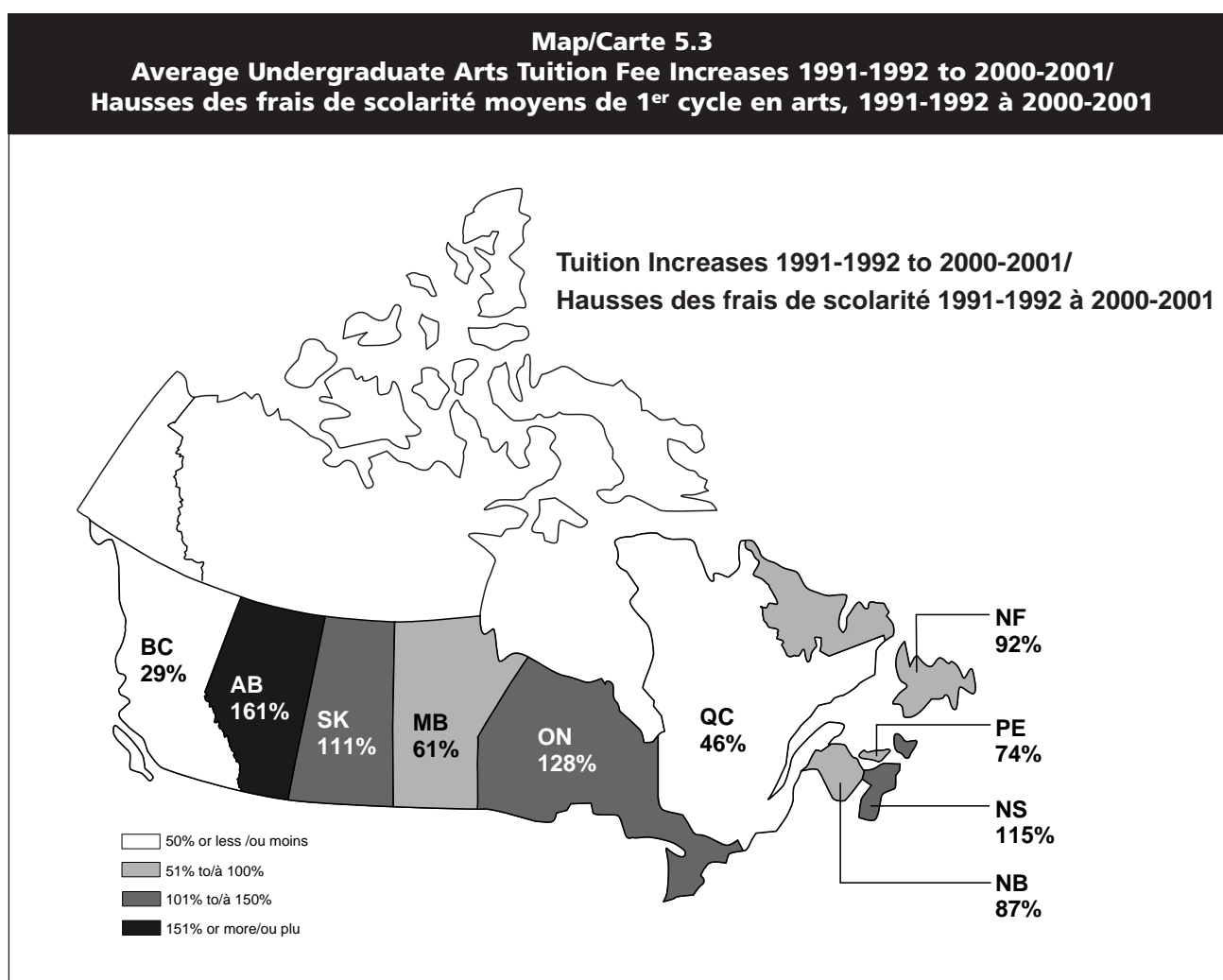
