Documentation Required for Nomination Package

1. Executive Committee Nomination Form

All candidates must submit a completed Nomination Form.

2. Letter of Nomination

All nomination packages must include a letter of nomination. Self-nominations will not be accepted. The letter of nomination will be included in the Council delegates' kit and available on-line.

3. Candidate Statement

All candidates must complete a statement of no more than 750 words that includes the agreement of the candidate to serve if elected and outlines their experience in academic staff association matters, their reasons for seeking election, and priorities and issues on which they feel CAUT should focus. Statements will be translated into English or French as applicable and will be included in the Council delegates' kit and available on-line.

Statements must not contain hyperlinks or attachments. A photo submission should be emailed to CAUTnominations-candidaturesACPPU@caut.ca and be at least 500 px wide by x 800 px tall at 150 DPI in JPEG or PNG format.
