Re: **Fair Employment Week, October 7-11, 2019**

Fair Employment Week (FEW) is taking place October 7-11, 2019. FEW is CAUT's annual campaign to build national support for contract academic staff.

This year, FEW will be part of the ***For Our Future*** federal election campaign and serve as a key moment in our efforts to raise the profile of precarious work as a key issue facing post-secondary education in Canada.

October 7th is also *World Day for Decent Work*, an annual mobilizing moment for unions and labour organizations around the world to call on governments to take concrete action for decent work.

FEW is an opportunity to:

- Raise awareness about the rise of precarious employment on campus and the unfair working conditions of one-third of academic staff in Canada; and,
- Highlight the contributions made by contract academic staff, under difficult employment conditions.

Local Event and Activities Tips and Tools

As you finalize the details of your FEW event(s), share them on the CAUT FEW [Events](#) web page. This digital map provides a visual of the national support for fairness for contract academic staff.

Activities which have proven successful in previous years include:

- Hold a reception or luncheon for your contract academic staff members.
- Hold an information picket on your campus, using FEW flyers or material targeted to your situation.
- Set up an information table in a high-traffic area of your campus where students, faculty and staff can find out about the campaign, sign a petition or express their support through a creative action, such as a photo booth.
- Hold a Local Hearing where decision-makers and the public can hear testimony from contingent faculty, students and others on the challenges they face.
- Bring resolutions about your issues forward for debate and consideration by your institution's decision-making bodies.
- Write op-ed pieces for your campus and community newspapers, radio stations and other media outlets. Invite the media to take part in FEW events.
- Encourage your contract academic staff members to share their stories on social media with the hashtag #makeitfair and #elxn43.
