Re: 2022 Mil Rate Survey

CAUT is updating our information on Mil Rates assessed by member associations. Most academic staff associations calculate membership dues based on a Mil Rate applied against salary.

CAUT fees are calculated based on a Mil Rate approved by Council and applied to the national average (mean) academic staff salary for each rank as reported by Statistics Canada. Provincial and local association dues may be calculated on a different basis, such as provincial salary averages or university and college salary averages, or sometimes as a fixed monthly or annual amount.

This <u>Excel table</u> contains the Mil rates reported to CAUT in 2021. Please take a moment to verify your information and do <u>one</u> of following:

- If the information is current, change the column "UPDATED AS OF" to '2022'.
- If the information is **not current**, please update the columns: "TOTAL COMBINED MIL RATE" and "UPDATED AS OF".
