#### Hotel

Be sure to mention the CAUT Council or group code **NF8** to obtain the preferred rates starting at \$226.00/night (Traditional guest room).

#### **Travel**

CAUT will cover the cost of transportation to Ottawa for one delegate per association. Travel should be booked early to take advantage of the lowest fares and **no later than October 29, 2024**. CAUT's policy is to use unionized carriers unless there is no other option available. Reservations **must** be made directly with CAUTs travel agency, *Corporate Traveller*, by email (<a href="mailto:stacey.thompson@corporatetraveller.ca">stacey.thompson@corporatetraveller.ca</a>) or by phone (1-613-236-2444). *Corporate Traveller* will require the booking code **24502** to make travel reservations and to bill CAUT directly.

Delegates travelling within 300 kilometres of Ottawa are encouraged to use available rail, bus, public transportation, or carpooling options.
