#### Hotel

## **Transportation**

CAUT will cover the transportation cost for one delegate per association.

Transportation should be booked early to take advantage of the lowest fares. **Bookings must be made by April 10, 2025**. Requests for transportation after this date will be approved only in exceptional circumstances.

CAUT's policy is to use unionized carriers unless there is no other option available. To help reduce carbon emissions that contribute to climate change, delegates should request direct flights and flights on fuel-efficient planes whenever possible. Delegates travelling within 300 kilometres of Ottawa are encouraged to use available rail, bus, public transportation, or carpooling options.
